Nestled in a protected natural area located at the foot of the Pic Saint Loup, the estate *Mas de Martin* is made up of 250 ha of wild scrubland which hosts 300 beehives and encircles 20 ha of vines aged 30 to 80 years and 1,000 olive trees. The buildings date, for the oldest part, from the 12th century and the wine cellar is housed in an old building dating from 1880.

The particular geographical situation of the estate offers cool nights which allows the vines to rest better at night and benefit from beautiful sunshine during the day. The vineyard has the particularity of offering a very qualitative average yield of 35 hl/ha. These factors added to the exceptional qualities of stony soils (sandstone) offer ideal conditions for obtaining optimum ripeness and aromatic freshness.
